While a previous workshop at the SETAC Basel conference in May 2014 was focussing on theory and concepts, emphasis in the second workshop will be on the practical application: where does it make sense today, what can be gained, what are implications and limitations, and what can be expected in future from addressing regional differences in LCIA.
